Surveillance Policy

WHC is committed to supporting our customers in maintaining safety and security within their homes. Many women have experienced domestic and family violence, some of whom have a current need for surveillance equipment to improve their security and deter people from using violence toward them. We have developed a new policy and application form for women in this situation to seek approval from WHC to install this equipment at their own cost. Note that you must gain approval before installation. The Policy also has links to specific requirements for using this equipment that legally need to be followed. For women linked with support to prevent DV, support providers can assist you in developing safety plans, improving your home security, assisting with this application and, in some instances, supporting the payment. The policy and application form can be found on our website - type in CCTV using the search function or call the office to have it posted to your home.

Rent Review - April 2025

Our rent reviews are conducted twice a year, and we have just completed our recent cycle with new rent in effect as of 28 April.

Important Information:

- Please ensure you have completed and signed the Application for Rental Subsidy Form and submitted it along with income evidence for yourself and any household members aged 18 or older.
- If you have not granted Centrelink consent to WHC or if you are employed, kindly provide your income documents as soon as possible.
- No further documentation is needed if you have already granted Centrelink consent for yourself and all household members. We will verify your income directly with Centrelink.
